

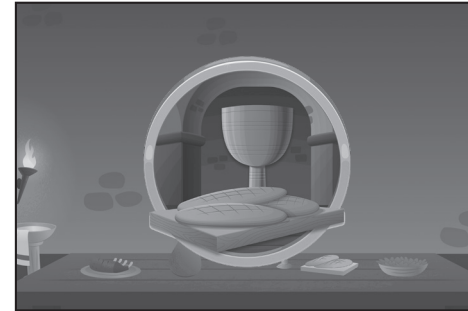

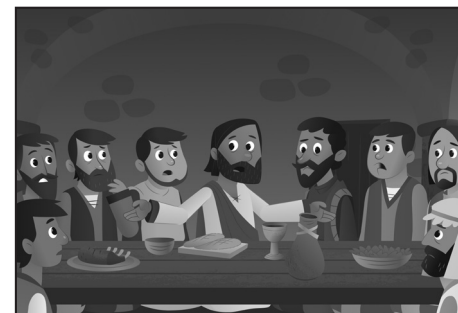


They hated Jesus so much that they decided to have Him killed. They gave thirty pieces of silver to Judas, one of Jesus' disciples, to hand Jesus over to them.
