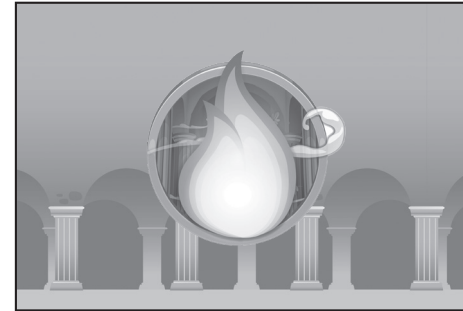


# God's Wonderful Gift



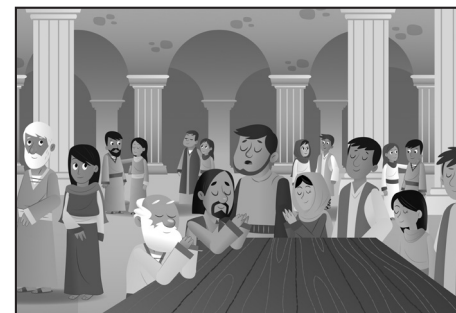
# God's Wonderful Gift
